Mental Health in Later Life: Interfacing the Body, Brain and Mind

Program Objectives

Participants will:

- 1. Discuss current provincial activities in the care of older adults and identify opportunities for participation and ways to stay informed about emerging changes in Ontario
- 2. Learn how to define Dementia by etiology and stage and review the issues of treatment and Delirium
- 3. Consider the impact of intergenerational trauma on the current population of Indigenous older adults with co-pathological presentations of Dementia with Anxiety and Depression
- 4. Incorporate an adult attachment model of interpersonal relationship styles in their understanding of how falls, pain and frailty can impact senior's mental health
- 5. Receive updates of current and emerging initiatives for Seniors' Care from a regional hospital perspective
- 6. Participants will describe common cognitive sequelae, mood and personality changes post-stroke and consider specific areas/pathways in the brain that are associated with the emergence of psychiatric symptoms
- 7. Participants will acknowledge the concept of biochemical individuality in mental health assessment of older adults and appreciate the importance of testing
