Our current call group consists of seven (7) generalists and one maternal-fetal medicine specialist. Our recruit would share call with the current team. Our Labour & Delivery unit welcomes around 1,700 babies each year, has its own dedicated Operating Room (OR), and is attached to PRHC's Level 2B NICU. We also provide OR time for gynecologic surgery, approximately two (2) full days per month, and the option to open your own clinic or join an existing group practise.

PRHC is a teaching site and we work with medical students on their core OB/GYN rotations as well as with family medicine residents based in Peterborough.

This is an exciting time to join the OB/GYN team at PRHC! We have big plans for the coming years. We are exploring new opportunities to enhance our Women's and Children's program, developing formal relationships with nearby community hospitals for which we serve as the referral centre, and continuing to partner and work closely with individuals and organizations in the greater Peterborough community. For those who are interested in quality improvement, in creative partnerships, and in leadership, this job will be of particular interest!
